After speaking with each track in your region INEX would like to inform all of the drivers in the Colorado, Wyoming, and Nebraska area of the following fuel rule update.

All competitors in the Colorado, Wyoming, and Nebraska area are required to run the specific TRACK FUEL designated by each specific track; Colorado National Speedway, I-25 Speedway, Big Country Speedway and HWY 92 Speedway.

Penalty for not using designated fuel will be disqualification, loss of points, and prize money.

Please be advised that INEX supports this above rule and its enforcement. This rule falls underneath the current INEX fuel rule and attempts to adhere to the spirit of Legends Racing and its Mission Statement. "This series is an attempt to fight the high costs involved in racing, and the rules are strictly enforced to ensure fair competition and cost control." We believe that this fuel rule is appropriate for this region of the country.
